### Adobe Illustrator Users:

All files coming out of Adobe Illustrator are needing to be in version CS2 or lower. For exact template sizes for your board that Epic Board Skins believes in are listed on the website under the size chart button. Here you will see proper finished size dimensions for you to choose from. Epic Board Skins production department does not have the capabilities of doing any kind of changes to the design at all. All production is doing is loading your pre prepped, pre designed file and loading into a RIP Software.

All files coming out of Illustrator are vector based files and if for some reason your Illustrator files do have images in them please make sure all imbedded images of a significant resolution when saving your files. All images must be (150pi) at full size. If your file is built at 50% scale then for best print quality the images then must be at (300dpi) . All fonts in your files must be converted to outlines as Epic Board Skins may not have the font you used installed in our systems and the files when we open them with want to get replaced with a different font. If this happens you may be notified of what changes need to be made so we can accept your file.

NOTE: All Files must be sent in rectangle format not in a shape of a board.

### CorelDraw Graphics Suite Users:

All files coming out of CorelDraw Graphics Suite are needing to be in version X4 or lower. For exact template sizes for your board that Epic Board Skins believes in are listed on the website under the size chart button. Here you will see proper finished size dimensions for you to choose from. Epic Board Skins production department does not have the capabilities of doing any kind of changes to the design at all. All production is doing is loading your pre prepped, pre designed file and loading into a RIP Software.

All files coming out of CorelDraw Graphics Suite are vector based files and if for some reason your CorelDraw Graphics Suite files do have images in them please make sure all imbedded images of a significant resolution when saving your files. All images must be (150dpi) at full size. If your file is built at 50% scale then for best print quality the images then must be at (300dpi) . All fonts in your files must be converted to outlines as Epic Board Skins may not have the font you used installed in our systems and the files when we open them with want to get replaced with a different font. If this happens you may be notified of what changes need to be made so we can accept your file.

### Adobe Photoshop Users:

All files coming out of Adobe Photoshop are needing to be in version CS2 or lower. For exact template sizes for your board that Epic Board Skins believes in are listed on the website under the size chart button. Here you will see proper finished size dimensions for you to choose from. Epic Board Skins production department does not have the capabilities of doing any kind of changes to the design at all. All production is doing is loading your pre prepped, pre designed file and loading into a RIP Software.

All files coming out of Adobe Photoshop are all image based files. If you are saving and sending us a .PSD file we don't want layers we want your flattened image. This image must be saved at a resolution not lower than 150dpi at Full Scale if at 50% scale they must be saved as 300dpi.) . All fonts in your files must be converted to outlines as Epic Board Skins may not have the font you used installed in our systems and the files when we open them with want to get replaced with a different font. If this happens you may be notified of what changes need to be made so we can accept your file. If you would like you can save your PSD file to a TIFF or JPG format, these will load right into our RIP Software as well. If you are saving as a JPG or a TIFF from here these formats must be saved as 150dpi at full scale and 300dpi at ½ Scale

NOTE: All Files must be sent in rectangle format not in a shape of a board.

### Scanned Images & Artwork:

All scanning must be also done at a high resolution. Meaning if the image is 8.5" x 11" (standard paper size) then your image must be scanned at no less than 600dpi in order to make it nice at almost 10 X its scanned size.

NOTE: If colour is involved and you want your image in colour, then you make the call on your scan, until you happy with it yourself.
